7. TO Mrs Nora Connolly O'Brien the sum of TWENTY FIVE POUNDS
8. TO Mrs Annie Palmer (Nannie) the sum of TWENTY FIVE POUNDS
9. TO Mrs Timmerman the sum of FIFTY POUNDS
10. TO my god-daughter Anne Keating the sum of ONE HUNDRED POUNDS
11. TO the Trustees of Alexander College, Guild House the sum of FIFTY POUNDS
12. TO the Medical Missionaries of Mary Drogheda with my deepest gratitude the sum of ONE HUNDRED POUNDS.
