Further to your request above, I am pleased to inform you that permission has been granted subject to compliance with the following conditions:

- The Minister for Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht and the State, their servants and agents, the Commissioners of Public Works, their servants and agents, the Minister for Finance and the State are indemnified against all actions, suits, claims, proceedings, costs or expenses in respect of any loss, accident or damage of any nature to any person or property whatsoever arising out of the granting of this permission. Evidence of a **public liability insurance policy in the sum of €6.5m** has been submitted prior to filming.
- 2. You will complete a site-specific risk assessment and method statement for this and make these available to OPW.
- 3. You will be responsible for leaving the site in a clean and tidy condition after use.
- 4. You will be responsible for the cost of making good any damage caused to the site arising out of its use.
- 5. There must be no fixing/mounting of any object to any wall or ground surface area of the site.
- 6. All lighting must be installed as set out in your method statement with all installations to be free standing and without fixings to ground or wall surfaces.

- 7. Any equipment left on site for the duration of this access is done so at your own risk and OPW accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to any property.
- 8. A facility fee of €945.00 + Vat @23% must be paid. An invoice and banking details for payment will be forwarded separately.
- 9. Permission is granted to film for 'Dorothy's Prison Notebooks'. Footage filmed at Kilmainham Gaol is not to be used by third-parties without the permission of The Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government, the Commissioners of Public Works. A copy of the documentary must be made available to OPW if requested, and the cooperation of the Office of Public Works should be acknowledged.
